* A bevezető Andante jelen verziójában egy obligát fuvolaszólammal kísért korálharmonizáció formáját ölti, ahogyan léteznek is Bachnak ilyen dallamhangszer-kíséretes korálfeldolgozásai. Ennek szellemében a billentyűjátékosnak kell vezetnie, követve a koráldallam természetes tempóját és frazeálását, a fuvolásnak ehhez kell alkalmazkodnia. Ezt szolgálják a gyakoribb, de rövid, a folyamatosságot nem akadályozó levegővételekre utaló javaslatok is.

* *In the present version, the Andante introduction takes the form of a chorale harmonisation accompanied by an obligato flute solo, as Bach did on several occasions. In this spirit, the keyboard player must lead, following the natural tempo and phrasing of the chorale melody, and the flutist must adapt. This is also served by the suggestions for more frequent but short breaths that do not disturb continuity.*






